The workshare season will run from the first week in June to the last week in September. Shifts will typically be 4-5 hours depending on the day's tasks. The Monday shift will be general farm task; seeding, transplanting, weeding, building beds, and everything else that goes into farming. Tuesday and Thursday mornings are harvest shifts. You will learn the final steps in the production system with harvesting from the field, washing, and packing away for various markets. We are also looking for a volunteer to help with cut flower production and bouquet assembly. Volunteers are expected to fulfill their weekly shift obligation throughout the season, or find a sub. If you cannot make it to your scheduled shift you must try and find a substitute. Please also let us know at least a week in advance so we can also make sure someone is there to cover for you. We will provide a list of subs and encourage people to get more friends involved.

Throughout the season we hope to share our knowledge of small-scale no till farming. There are many opportunities to dig in and get your hands dirty learning. We are open to new ideas and excited to learn from our volunteers as well. Each week workshares will receive their share of produce. Also, we will provide lunch every other week for our volunteers post-harvest (Tuesday/Thursday). If anyone has an interest in helping with lunch and farm to table style cooking please reach out or share this opportunity. We ask workshares to please bring your own reusable bag to collect your farm share each week. Lastly, we will invite all workshares who complete their obligations to join our end of season party. We will have a celebration of some sort to commemorate the season and all the hard work of everyone involved. More details to come, but you can expect a good time.
